

Park Board Minutes

February 12, 2018

Present: Joann, Greg, Randy, Steve, and Pat. Absent: Nichole and Diane

Lake and Fishing Contest news: 832 were registered for fishing with about 1200 people overall. There is 23.5 inches of ice and the oxygen levels are good.

Bench Plaques: 2 new plaques have been made for the Servicemen's Club and 2 name plates were made for the 2 other benches. There are a total of 8 benches by the lake.

Shelter Reservations for 2017: there were 27 reservations at Sportsman Park, 38 at Allison, 1 at South, 2 at Eagles. 65 tables were rented out. Amanda Moreno will handle reservations at the campground. Steve will look into key lockboxes with a code.

Joe's Camper Show asked if we would like to have a booth to hand out our brochures. It was decided not to do this since someone would have to be there. It is March 14-18.

Applications are being accepted for 2 part time people for the summer months. These people would be available for all departments. Interviews will begin soon.

Skating Rink attendance is winding down and after the warmer temps this week, it may over.

The Park Dept. has redone 37 picnic tables, been trimming trees, received the 36 new chaise lounge chairs for the pool and will replacing about 1000 feet of polycap fence guard at ball fields.

The Lake Improvement committee will start up again, with the purpose of creating a spawning area in the slough behind St. Mary's and a channel leading to the lake.

Joann reported that someone is going to be hired to update the City's website, which could be used for camping sign up or a Boulevard tree list for example.
