Arbor Day will be held on Thursday, May 3 (rain date May 8<sup>th</sup>) at South Park. More at the next meeting.

The Water Parks rates will remain the same, as some of our fees are a little higher than other parks.

Two seasonal city employees have been hired. Anna Lux and Megan Labat. They will begin around May 7 through end of August.

1 Paddle Port will be discussed at the City Council tomorrow night. The Park Dept. will provide space on the beach and Chris Andres will be in charge of it.

Four concerts are scheduled for Music in the Park, 2 in June and 2 in July.

Lights in Motion committee presented the Park Board with a lengthy wish list. It is on hold for the time being.

The tractor maintenance expenses between 2014-2017 are \$2,640 for the newest tractor and \$600 for the older tractor. Parts for the newer tractor just cost more.

A new trailer will be purchased through Eugene Sellner Auto Sales for \$1400. The Utilities Dept. will be selling their Ford 350 dump truck; we are considering it along with the wastewater dept.

Steve talked to Dennis Fromm from Towns Edge about code-push button door locks on the camper cabin doors. It should work.

The disc golf course has been tweaked moving 2 holes away from trees and other obstacles.
