# Rules & Regulations for Sportsmen Park-Sleepy Eye, MN Park is open from May 1 through October. Weather permitting.

# Campground

- 16 campsites; electricity (20, 30, and 50 Amp plugins) and water to all sites.
- Each campsite has a fire ring and a picnic table.
- Only one vehicle allowed per site. All other vehicles must be parked in the lot.
- Only one camper per site. You may have one additional tent at the site.
- All sites are back in only. NO PULL THROUGHS!
- Dump station is available.
- All campsites are 60 feet long.
- No parking on the grass.
- Campsites rental is \$30.00 per night, plus tax.

#### Camper cabins

- Each cabin is heated and air-conditioned.
- One tent allowed on each site.
- Pine Cabin is handicapped accessible with 3 twin and 1 full size beds.
- Oak Cabin has 2 twin and 2 full size beds.
- No cooking in cabins coffee pot and or crockpot only.
- Additional cabin rules are posted in each cabin.
- Cabin rent is \$65.00 per night, plus tax.

### General campground rules

- Check in time is 3:00 pm.
- Check out time is 1:00 pm.
- Quiet time is 10:00 pm to 6:00 am.
- Excessive noise will not be tolerated.
- City ordinance forbids glass containers in our parks.
- All city parks close at 10:00 pm unless an extended time permit is obtained.
- We ask that you collect all garbage and recyclables and put them in their proper containers.
- Camping permits will not be issued for more than 14 consecutive nights but may be renewed if there is an open site.

#### Reservations

- Reservations can be made after January 1 for the coming summer.
- Reservations can be made by stopping in a Sleepy Eye City Hall, 200 Main St. East. Reservations have to be paid for when you stop in. New Rule for 2018.
- Call in reservation can be made by calling 507-794-3736. Send check or money order within 2 weeks (14 days). If not received by then, the reservation will be released. New Rule for 2018.
- We have a NO REFUND POLICY. New Rule for 2018.

## General Rules for Sleepy Eye Parks

- All parks close at 10:00 pm.
- Use of fireworks or other explosives are prohibited in all city parks.
- Pets must be restrained or on a leash at all times. Owners must pick up after their pets.
- Campfires may only be built in the fire rings or grills provided. No big fires allowed. Be sure your fire is extinguished before leaving. Do not leave fires unattended. You are responsible for keeping your fire under control.
- Keep all garbage picked up when you are enjoying our parks.
- Leave natural areas the way you found them. No chopping, carving, cutting or damaging any live tree.
