Sportsman's Park updates:

Ice out on lake was Sunday April 7.

New dock for campground has arrived and will be installed in the future.

Permits have arrived from MDH and for the plumbing work needed for the 8 new camping sites.

8 new tables' frames have been obtained for these sites.

New fire rings have been purchased for the campground. New locations to accommodate larger RV will be determined in placement.

Steve will work on a list of needs for the park, as a donor is willing to provide funds for parts or some of those needs.

RVS sanitation will hold a recycle day for electronics, appliances, and other items on May 15, 2019 from 12 noon to 6 PM at Eagles Park. Look for posters that provide fees for disposal of the items.

Arbor Day will be held May 2, 2019 at 1:30 PM at South Park with a rain date of May 6, 2019. Speakers and program are being arranged.

Other park department work:

Tree trimming continues throughout the city.

Ag lime application will be done at the softball fields.

Tiling system has been working well.

Concerns about removal of the many mature trees in South Park resulting in no shade over playground equipment were brought to board.
